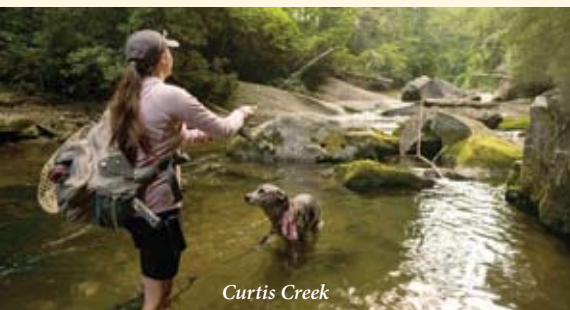

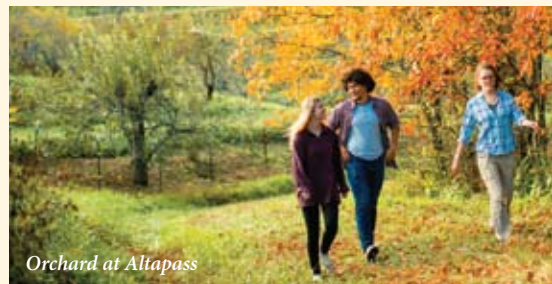

ON A TRAIL

Old Fort Area

Bernard Mountain Trail

A new 3-mile trail linking Mills Creek Rd to Lookout Point Trail with technical bike features and diverse terrain.

Catawba Falls Trail

Moderate to Strenuous 3.4-mile round trip trail that offers stunning views of 280 foot multi-cascading waterfall. The new Ridge Trail offers a return loop.

Copper Ridge Trail

Moderate/Strenuous hiking/biking 3-mile trail with switchbacks.

Curtis Creek Recreation Area /Pisgah National Forest

Multiple moderate to strenuous trails for hiking, biking and equestrian adventures.

Hickory Nut Branch

Moderate 3-mile round trip trail with waterfalls and wildflowers.

Snook's Nose

Climb steeply to the rock outcrop that gives the trail its name and go further to the Green Knob Overlook on Blue Ridge Parkway. Strenuous hike.

Kitsuma Peak Trail

8.7 mile out and back challenging trail. Very popular with mountain bikers.

Newberry Creek

Easy walk on gravel forest road before a strenuous ascent to the Blue Ridge Parkway.

Old Fort Gateway Trail System

Multi-use trail system with 6 miles completed of a 42 miles planned expansion. Off Curtis Creek Road. Easy to moderate with multiple loop options.

Point Lookout Trail

Paved non-motorized trail with views of the Royal Gorge. 3.7 miles one way.

State Long Distance Trails that Pass Through McDowell

Fonta Flora Trail

A hiking/biking trail that will eventually connect Morganton to Asheville. Completed sections can be found at Lake James, Marion, and Old Fort.

Mountains to Sea Trail

Parts of section four traverse McDowell County.

Wilderness Gateway State Trail

100-mile trail that will connect Chimney Rock to the South Mountain State Parks. Runs along the southern border of McDowell County.

Overmountain Victory National Historic Trail

National Historic Trail covering four states and 300 miles. Varying lengths and skill levels. Part goes through McDowell County between Lake James and the Blue Ridge Parkway. There are 57 accessible miles of trail. Some sections are for motorized travel.

OUTDOOR RECREATION

When it comes to trails, elevation matters. In this region, elevation ranges between 1500 to 3500 feet above sea level.

Create memorable adventures by hiking a waterfall trail, casting flies on cool mountain trout streams, or entertaining the family by identifying “critters” and plants. Lake James is filled with a variety of sports fish and is host to annual bass fishing tournaments. Find fishing guidelines and locations online. www.ncwildlife.org

Marion’s McDowell Greenway is a relaxing way to spend time at the Catawba River. The handicap accessible, paved trail includes plenty of benches and overlooks. It’s a site on the N.C. Birding Trail, a perfect way to start the day.

Schedule a tee time at North Cove Leisure Club and Disc Golf Course or the Marion Lake Golf Club.



Miles of hiking trails

ON A TRAIL Marion Area

Joseph McDowell Greenway

Paved non-motorized 1.5 mile trail, easy walk or bike ride, bordering the Catawba River.

Mt Ida Trail

Half mile moderate/strenuous trail overlooking downtown Marion.

Peavine Trail

1.5-mile former railroad corridor repurposed trail in Marion starting on State St.

Tom’s Creek Falls

One-mile round trip hike to an 80 ft multi-cascading waterfall in the Pisgah National Forest.

Wood’s Mountain

Hike or bike this 26-mile loop. Not for the faint of heart! Rollercoaster climbs with epic descents.



Point Lookout Trail

Near By

Mt. Mitchell State Park

At 6,684 feet, the mountain is the highest point east of the Mississippi River, and an observation deck provides breathtaking mountain views on a clear day. Easy trails at the summit explore the Fraser fir forest, while a vast network of challenging trails — including the Mountains-to-Sea State Trail — extend into adjacent wilderness areas and lead to backpacking opportunities within Pisgah National Forest.

Linville Gorge Wilderness Area/ Linville Falls

The Linville Gorge Wilderness is part of the Pisgah National Forest. The gorge is formed by the Jonas Ridge on the east and Linville Mountain on the west and is bisected by the Linville River which drops 2,000 feet into the valleys below. The terrain is

steep and rugged with numerous rock formations. Recreation opportunities include hiking, backpacking, rock climbing, fishing and hunting.

Lake James State Park

Lake James State Park includes two areas to access this picturesque lake that is perfect for boating, swimming, and fishing. Campsites at both Catawba River and Paddy’s Creek accesses provide an opportunity to spend the night by the lake, with some sites accessible only by paddling. Trails include bike trails at Paddy’s Creek, the kid-friendly Holly Discovery Trail, the historic Overmountain Victory Trail, and the Fonta Flora State Trail.

FISHING & WATERSPORTS

All N.C. Wildlife Commission regulations apply, whether you are sports fishing on Lake James and the Catawba River or searching for a great public trout stream. Exceptions include privately owned ponds and farms and the specially designated trout waters on Mill Creek at Mountain Gateway Museum. The Old Fort section is included in the Wildlife Commission's Mountain Heritage Trout Town Program. Licenses are available online at www.ncwildlife.org or by calling 888-248-6834.

Game lands portion. 4 miles with tight creek, well-stocked.

North Fork of the Catawba River

Headwaters located in North Cove community.

Armstrong Creek

2 miles with large holes.

Mill Creek

6 miles. • Delayed Harvest

Curtis Creek

5 miles with easy access. • Catch & Release/Artificial Lures-Only Waters. Season is year-round. Fish may not be harvested or possessed. Lure restrictions are artificial lures with one single hook only.

Newberry Creek

3 miles stocked with Brook Trout.

Wild Trout Waters

No closed season. Daily creek limit is four with minimum size of 7". Lures are restricted to artificial lures with one single hook only.

OLD FORT - BIRTHPLACE OF THE PISGAH NATIONAL FOREST

Old Fort has been called the promised land of mountain biking. Surrounded by 70,000 acres of Pisgah National Forest, the steep slopes and single tracks appeal to both bikers and hikers.

Why "Birthplace Of The Pisgah National Forest?" In 1911, The Weeks Act made it possible to purchase land for conservation and preservation creating the national forest system.

This section of Pisgah Forest and the Curtis Creek Area includes Phase I (six miles of the 42-mile plan) of the recently opened Old Fort Gateway Trail System. The mixed-use trail complex includes a handicap-accessible section and a trout fishing deck.

This terrain lends itself to off-road racing. Check out the

Hellbender 100 (foot race), the Rock n Roller - Old Fort Edition (back road bicycle ride), and the mountain bike races including the Off-Road Assault on Mt. Mitchell, the Jerdon Mountain Challenge, and the Pisgah Enduro Race.

Andrew's Geyser Park

Built in 1879 as a tourism attraction, Andrews Geyser was named to honor Western North Carolina Railroad officer, Alexander Boyd Andrews. The geyser was part of the property surrounding the Round Knob Hotel. In 1903, the hotel burned, and the owners decided not to rebuild. The geyser was such a popular attraction, one of its admirers paid to have it moved to the opposite side of the creek, and today it's part of a public park owned by the Town of Old Fort. Park hours are dawn until dusk. Picnic tables are available on-site, there are no toilet facilities.

This 157-acre property includes two challenging courses and is a short drive to Linville Caverns and the Blue Ridge Parkway. If disc golf isn't for you, hit the links at Marion Lake Club. This public course is the only golf course with views of spectacular Lake James. Both courses include onsite bar and grill service.



On the Greenway

BLUE RIDGE PARKWAY COMMUNITIES

Within the National Park Service system, the Blue Ridge Parkway is one of the most visited parks. In our area, you have access to three entry points, NC Highway 80 (at the intersection of US 70), from downtown Marion US Highway 221N, and US Highway 226N. A local and visitor favorite, you'll find the seasonal community of Little Switzerland between two favorite waterfalls, Crabtree and Linville at Milepost 334.



Blue Ridge Parkway

Cool, a word to describe everything related to Little Switzerland, including the weather! With elevations between 3200 and 4000 feet above sea level, atmospheric conditions put a new twist on each day.

Mountain culture is shared through storytelling and traditional arts and music. Summertime square dances are still popular ways to spend a Saturday night.

These mountains are where you'll find the "curvy roads" like the infamous DiamondbackNC with

190 curves covering 12 miles of two-lane blacktop. Take home DiamondbackNC swag, locally crafted glassworks, jewelry, and more when you visit the shops at the Switzerland Inn.

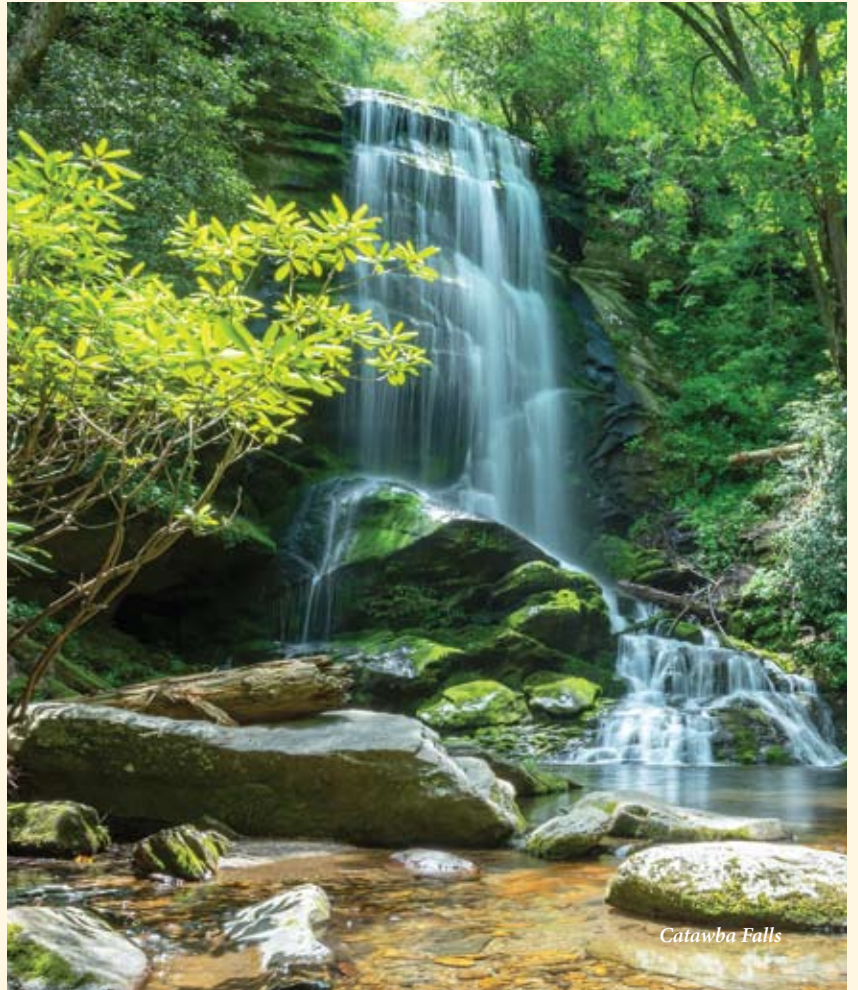
